**BOARD APPROVES COMPREHENSIVE
COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM**

In June of 2014, the YSA Board of Directors approved a broad based plan to reach out to the general public in Yolo, Sacramento, Napa, and Contra Costa counties. The goal is to inform the public that YSA has tremendous facilities that are available to everyone. It is the board's intention to introduce our family friendly club to more children, women, and closet sportsmen in the area. Of course, many of the areas avid sportsmen are still unaware of the club's existence and we want them to come visit our facilities as well.

First, this broad based plan includes a new 4ft x 8ft elevated sign on Road 29 that clearly marks the club's location and posts an open invitation to the public to come in. Secondly, the board approved and invested in the technology enabling members and the public to use credit cards at the club. This ensures everyone that they can use the facility even if they are not carrying sufficient cash with them. Thirdly, new brochures and post cards about the club have been printed and distributed to sporting good stores throughout these 5 counties.

Two other initiatives were also undertaken; the club has begun a radio advertizing campaign on Sep Hendrickson's California Sportsmen Radio, 1140 AM, heard by 75,000 outdoor enthusiasts every week. Sep is a YSA member and really stepped up on the club's behalf: he gave the club a discount on the advertising price, produced an incredible ad that is aired weekly and held a live, nine minute interview with board member Jeff Butler, talking about the wonderful club, its facilities, reasonable members fees and day-fees. Furthermore, Sep will be putting together a special day at the club for his listeners— stay tuned to hear the date and the special activities that are planned; and lastly, the board has undertaken a complete re-do of the YSA website including its soon initiation into the world of social media. The site is under construction now at www.yolosportsmen.com. Check it out as it grows and improves of the next couple of months.
